LETTER OF INTEREST AND SUPPORT FOR EPONA

The Walcha First Nations Community is pleased to confirm its interest in supporting the continued development of the feature film project Epona, written by Leila McDougall and Shannon Green and being developed by VAM Paddock Productions.

Members and representatives of the Walcha First Nations Community are willing to assist with the development of the screenplay, particularly in relation to the First Nations characters, cultural themes, local history, language, connection to Country and other cultural material proposed for inclusion in the film.

This involvement will be undertaken in accordance with the Epona First Nations Cultural Governance, Consultation and Collaboration Framework. The framework provides the basis for respectful consultation, appropriate cultural guidance, informed consent and the protection of Indigenous Cultural and Intellectual Property throughout the development process.

The community's involvement during screenplay development may include reviewing relevant story material, identifying cultural matters requiring further consultation, advising on cultural accuracy and authenticity, and assisting the filmmakers to ensure that First Nations perspectives are treated with respect and integrity.

This letter confirms the community's willingness to participate in the current screenplay development stage. It does not constitute approval of the final screenplay, the use of any particular cultural material, or the community's participation in the production or later stages of the film.

Any involvement in future stages of Epona, including further development, preproduction, filming, postproduction, marketing, distribution or community engagement, will be discussed separately with the appropriate community representatives. The nature of that involvement, cultural governance arrangements, responsibilities, permissions, fees and any other relevant terms will be agreed upon before those activities proceed.

The Walcha First Nations Community welcomes the opportunity to continue discussions with VAM Paddock Productions and to contribute to a development process founded on respect, transparency, collaboration and genuine cultural authority.
